TAG brings together students **aged 15–18** twice a month from **October 2016 to May 2017**. Students experiment with and learn different art techniques as well as tour and discuss gallery exhibitions. These **after school** sessions alternate between the Vancouver Art Gallery and Emily Carr University.
